

Reaping the Whirlwind

RECENT cheery news was that the former Metropolitan Police Commissioner, Sir John Stevens, believes that there are two hundred Al Qaeda operatives at large in Great Britain. His successor as Britain's top copper, Sir Ian Blair, warns that we face a terrorist threat from Muslim men who have trained in Afghanistan. While he is "very concerned about the Muslim community's sense of belonging... there would be a much greater outcry if we did absolutely nothing and part of London disappeared in smoke".

It's reassuring to know that our 'politically correct' top policemen have time for other things than harassing motorists, beating up hunt followers in Parliament Square to please New Labour, and race, gender and homophobia awareness courses. But his employers - we, the overtaxed, law abiding British majority - must ask how things have come to this.

What is happening is very interesting. The creaking edifice of the much-praised multi-racial society is beginning to fall apart under the weight of its own contradictions. In the longer term, its dissolution is probably inevitable. There is, in the long-run, no successful multi-racial, multi-cultural or even multi-religious society in the world. Think of Bosnia, Kosovo, Sri Lanka, 'Zimbabwe', or Northern Ireland. The process is now accelerating rapidly, not thanks to the warnings of its far-sighted critics, but to the folly of its most odious supporters - chief amongst them Tony Blair.

Blair's policy is mass immigration to provide cheap labour for his friends in big business. On present trends, it will lead to the British people becoming an ethnic minority in our own country by the end of this century.

The natural tendency of human beings to cluster together with their kith and kin - never condemned in immigrant populations though it's called racism if practised by the natives - has already led to the creation of vast, alienated ghettos in which the increasingly misnamed ethnic minorities develop separately from the mainstream of British society. A good name for this unattractive social system would be 'apartness'. Think about it.

The creation of alienated enclaves is already having serious consequences. Mao Tse Tung once said that the revolutionary is a fish, and the people are the sea in which the fish swims. 99.99% of the Muslim community is not involved in terrorism, and about 97% of it is opposed to terrorism. But since it took only a handful of men to blow up a railway station in Madrid, it

is not a great consolation to know that there are 'only' a few hundred terrorists amongst us. We cannot tell them apart from anyone else. Nor can the security services, at least not every time. Scarcely surprising when we have hardly any border controls, and the Government has no idea who is here. As a past Prime Minister, Stanley Baldwin, once put it, the bomber will always get through.

Having created a problem which did not exist fifty years ago, the political class has failed to grasp the full implications of its decades of folly, neglect and betrayal. Nor has it moved on from the preoccupations of a Cold War long gone by. What passes for 'British' foreign policy amounts - in the words of the late, great Enoch Powell at the outset of the first Iraq war - to finding out what the Americans want, and doing it. Blair joined Bush's invasion of Iraq on a dodgy dossier of false intelligence and dubious legal advice. Not in pursuit of British interests, but in a Pavlov's dog like response to American demands.

I have some good news for our leaders. In case they hadn't heard, Stalin is dead. The days are long gone when there could be any possible justification for pandering to Washington's whims. Maybe it was once necessary to keep the United States in Europe to fend off a Soviet threat. The Soviet threat may or may not have been a paper tiger. In any event, it ceased to exist fifteen years ago. 'American' foreign policy is itself a misnomer. It is dictated not by the real interests of the American people, whose sons are suffering, bleeding and dying in Iraq for no good cause, but by special interest groups which influence those in power in the US.

The Muslim community perceives the realities of Blair's war far better than the majority community. We can't just blame Muslims for their anger and alienation, as some foolish and incendiary demagogues do. We too are victims of the international interests who misrule us for their own ends.

Our political class, which has brought millions of immigrants to these overcrowded isles without any mandate from the British people for changing our whole society, now provokes the Muslim community by committing just about every crime charged at the Nuremberg trials against their fellow Muslims in Iraq. Crimes against peace, crimes against humanity, conspiracy to wage aggressive war, torture of resistance fighters at Abu Ghraib prison and Guantanamo Bay concentration camp. It's the sort of thing we associate with

the Gestapo.

New Labour's war is thus bringing about the type of 'double alienation' so well known in Northern Ireland.

The Muslim community believes - with good reason - that the NuLab regime is subservient to the international power networks to which America's leaders defer. It will collaborate in invading and occupying Iran and Syria if that is what its puppet masters want. Muslims in England are to be imprisoned without trial in defiance of rulings of the House of Lords. Attacking ancient liberties may stop a Madrid style terrorist attack for a short while - everything is short-term political advantage with New Labour - but it will inevitably spawn even more alienation and terrorism before long among British born Muslim youth.

Meanwhile, the despised natives increasingly see themselves as victims of NuLab's ghastly array of race relations laws, its systematic vilification of British culture and traditions, and its 'positive' discrimination in favour of minority interests. 40% of trainee Crown Prosecutors are now from ethnic minorities! Where will it all end? As Michael Wharton - the *Daily Telegraph's* 'Peter Simple' - put it:

"This organised deception about race cannot last for ever. The wonder is that it has lasted so long. At last there are signs that it is coming to an end. Politicians of all parties will have to take that into account and try as best they may to cope with the problem of immigration they have evaded so disgracefully for the sake of a quiet life. The dreaded "race card" they have been so careful not to play is playing itself. The indigenous people of this country realise that "immigrants", "asylum seekers" and "ethnic minorities" are part of the same largely racial phenomenon.

'Given that millions of these "immigrants" or whatever you like to call them are settled here and that more are arriving all the time, what is the solution to this "problem of immigration"? ... perhaps, as with most problems, there is no solution. But there is certainly going to be an outcome, and a most unwelcome one, to say the least. Those who live longest, as the saying is, will see the most, unfortunately for them.'

We agree with all but one word of that. If the British people organise politically to protect our way of life, the outcome won't ultimately be unwelcome for us, however unwelcome it may be for the lords of misrule in the Lib/Lab/Con single party.

Some Freedom Party policies

IMMIGRATION Successive governments have failed the British people by allowing millions of immigrants to settle in these overcrowded isles without any democratic mandate for a reckless policy with incalculable social consequences. Economic migrants including bogus asylum seekers continue to enter the country at the rate of at least 200,000 a year, a city the size of Birmingham every five years. Millions of Britons are in reality jobless yet Labour constantly cites 'labour and skills shortages' as an excuse for yet more immigration. Large scale immigration drives down wages, and imposes ever greater burdens on the health service, the social security budget and the housing stock. It benefits only a few exploitative multinationals and greedy gang masters in search of cheap labour. We will regain control of our borders, stop the asylum scam, and expel illegal immigrants.

CRIME One of the key reasons for the rise in crime is that there is now little sense of common identity or purpose. Furthermore, the softly-softly attitude towards punishment has acted as a green light to criminals. Society is entitled to punish criminals. If retribution is seen to follow conviction for a criminal offence, potential offenders will be deterred from a life of crime. It is also important that victims of crime can see that justice is taking place. We will ensure that police resources are targeted towards catching criminals instead of pandering to 'politically correct' fashions, and persecuting motorists.

HEALTH The National Health Service must be maintained, but it can no longer be regarded as the free provider of cosmetic and other lifestyle aspects of health care. The vast bureaucracy that surrounds the NHS must be slashed. Private health insurance should be encouraged through the taxation system to ease the burden on the NHS. Above all, the National Health Service should be our people's health service, not an international health service for benefit and health care tourists.

EDUCATION We will encourage a mixture of schools, both private and state run, grammars and technical schools. We will encourage competition from an early age. We will ensure that the basics are well mastered by all pupils at primary level by the universal reintroduction of traditional teaching methods. Trendy and incompetent teachers must be replaced. A vital part of any child's education as a responsible citizen is being taught about our great past as a nation. There will be an end to multi-cultural brainwashing. Respect and discipline must be restored.

THE ECONOMY In principle we support an economy based on free enterprise, for we recognise that governments do not generally run industries well. We are however firmly committed to protecting the strategically important manufacturing, agricultural and fisheries sectors. It is also an important role of government to sustain demand by maintaining business confidence, and to ensure that a well-educated, highly trained and motivated workforce is available. If a workforce shares common ideals and society at large is harmonious and united, then economic performance is greatly enhanced. It is clearly the duty of government to do all it can to ensure that this is the case.

TRANSPORT We wish to encourage a greater use of public transport (railways, buses and even a revitalised canal network), but recognise that to do so the transport infrastructure must first be improved. It is madness to tax the motorist without providing viable alternatives. We are opposed to the over taxing of motorists and small hauliers.

EUROPE Britain's relationship with the European Union must be renegotiated. We are willing to participate in a trading bloc, but will never agree to being bound by laws dictated by unelected bureaucrats. If necessary we would withdraw altogether. Renegotiating our position would result in saving billions of pounds that can be better spent on improving the transport system or to re-finance the NHS. We will never sign away our sovereignty and independence by abolishing the Pound. We totally oppose the Euro, and back a national referendum on our future relationship with the EU.

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
